



Campsite Terms & Conditions

We welcome you to our naturist campsite Monte Naturista O Barão. We hope you will enjoy your stay with us. We will do our utmost to make your stay as enjoyable and comfortable as possible. Please read and understand the terms and conditions.

1. **Emergencies:** In emergency situations you can contact the owners, Jeff or Laura, at any time in the reception/bar, their house or phone number 00351 936710623. The emergency number in Portugal is **112**. The hospital and first aid is at approximately 30km between Santiago do Cacém and V.N. de Santo André on National Road EN261. In Santiago you can follow the signs to "Hospital" or "H". A pharmacy is in Ermidas-Sado, turn right before viaduct and follow this road until the end.
2. **Principal:** Monte Naturista O Barão is a campsite where people expect to be naked, if weather permits, and where people treat each other and nature with respect.
3. **Access:** Monte Naturista O Barão is open for everybody who lives by the principal described in 1. Children under age 16 will be permitted if accompanied by parents or chaperone. By accessing the campsite you accept these terms and conditions.
4. **Own risk:** Accessing the campsite and participating in any activities are at own risk.
5. **Arrival and departure:** On arrival, every visitor is kindly asked to report to the reception with an identity card. On arrival visitors need to make sure they read the prices, terms & conditions, etc. to prevent misunderstandings. On departure we expect visitors to leave their pitch tidied and clean, ready for the next visitor.
6. **Payment:** We would appreciate payments in the hours when the reception is open.
7. **Terrain:** The gate is to be closed by in or outgoing visitors. The maximum speed on the terrain is 5km/h (walking speed). After 23h30 we request silence on the terrain. Keep the terrain clean. Do not throw cigarettes or other things on the ground.
8. **Bar:** Visitors are not allowed to bring their own drinks or food to the bar.
9. **Rubbish and chemicals:** Glass bottles and rubbish (in a closed bag) are to be disposed in the containers outside of the terrain at the right side of the gate. Do this dressed or covered by a towel! Portable toilets, free of chemicals, can be emptied and rinsed at the specially made disposal point.
10. **Water:** Water is scarce. Therefore we expect visitors not to use excessive amounts of water. It is not drinking water.
11. **Swimming pool:** Please use the shower before swimming. No clothes in and around the pool. Children must be accompanied by an adult.
12. **Environment and septic tank:** Thinking of the environment and to prevent problems with our septic tank we try to live as "green" as possible. To clean the bath house we use bio-degradable soaps and for our washing machine we use natural washing soap. So, to help us, please throw the toilet paper in the bins and do not use chemicals.
13. **Danger of fire:** It is not allowed to make a bonfire or a BBQ with either charcoal or wood on the pitch. There are BBQ areas, everyone may use them. It is not allowed to throw any cigarettes on the ground.
14. **Animals:** Dogs on the terrain are on a lead and are to do their needs outside the terrain. Owners of dogs are expected to clean up after their dog. It is not allowed to feed Nelly, the goat. Stray dogs may not be fed; if you see one report this to the management.
15. **Complaints:** Please report complaints as soon as possible!
16. Every person on the campsite is expected to know the terms & conditions. Should a situation occur which is not covered by the above please speak to us and a decision will be made. The management can request a visitor to leave the campsite, at any time.

These terms & conditions are not to limit your freedom but to keep the campsite a safe, pleasant and livable environment for everyone.
